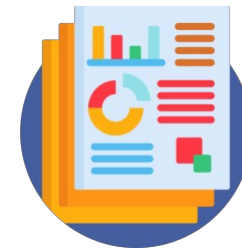
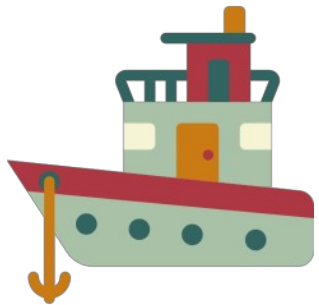

# What is Halal?

- Halal (حلال) : "permissible" or "lawful" according to Islamic Law (Sharia)

يَا أَيُّهَا النَّاسُ كُلُوا مِمَّا فِي الْأَرْضِ حَلَالًا طَيِّبًا وَلَا تَتَّبِعُوا خُطُوَاتِ الشَّيْطَانِ إِنَّهُ لَكُمْ عَدُوٌّ مُبِينٌ ﴿١٦٨﴾

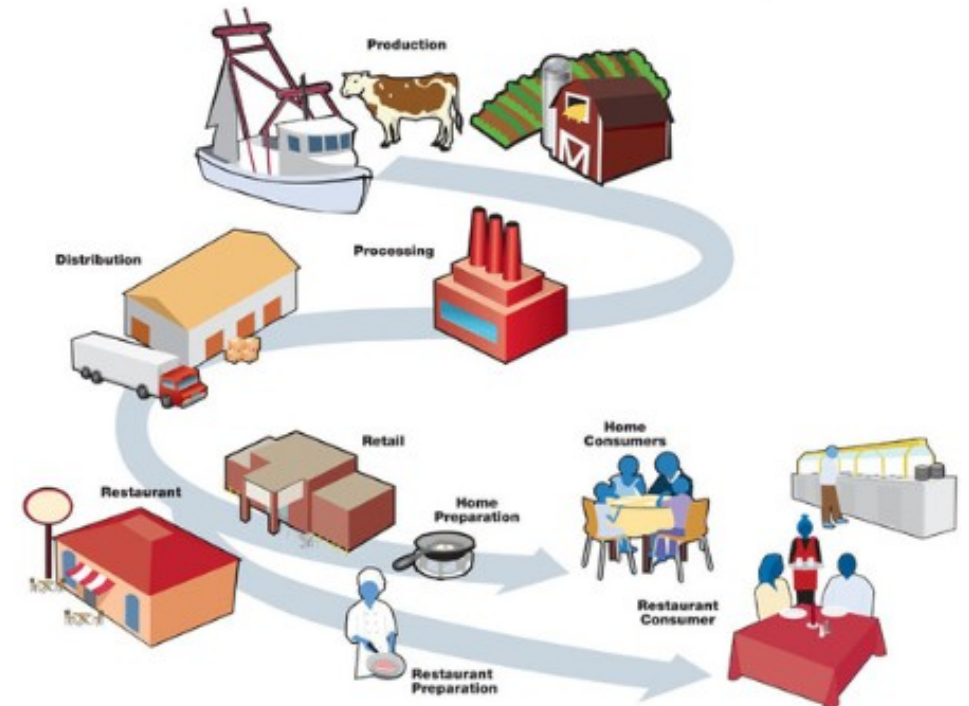
- ‘Halalan Tayyiban’ from Surat Al- Baqarah (168), it is the concept include that requirements coming from Sharia with good practices and the product or the service must comply both at the same time
- Halal Certification is not limited to food products; it addresses a wide range of sectors such as finance, textiles, pharmaceuticals, cosmetics, logistics and tourism.



# Importance of Halal Logistics

- According to the concept of 'Farm to Table' in Halal, it is as important to deliver Halal conditions to the consumer as it is to produce Halal.

## General Flow

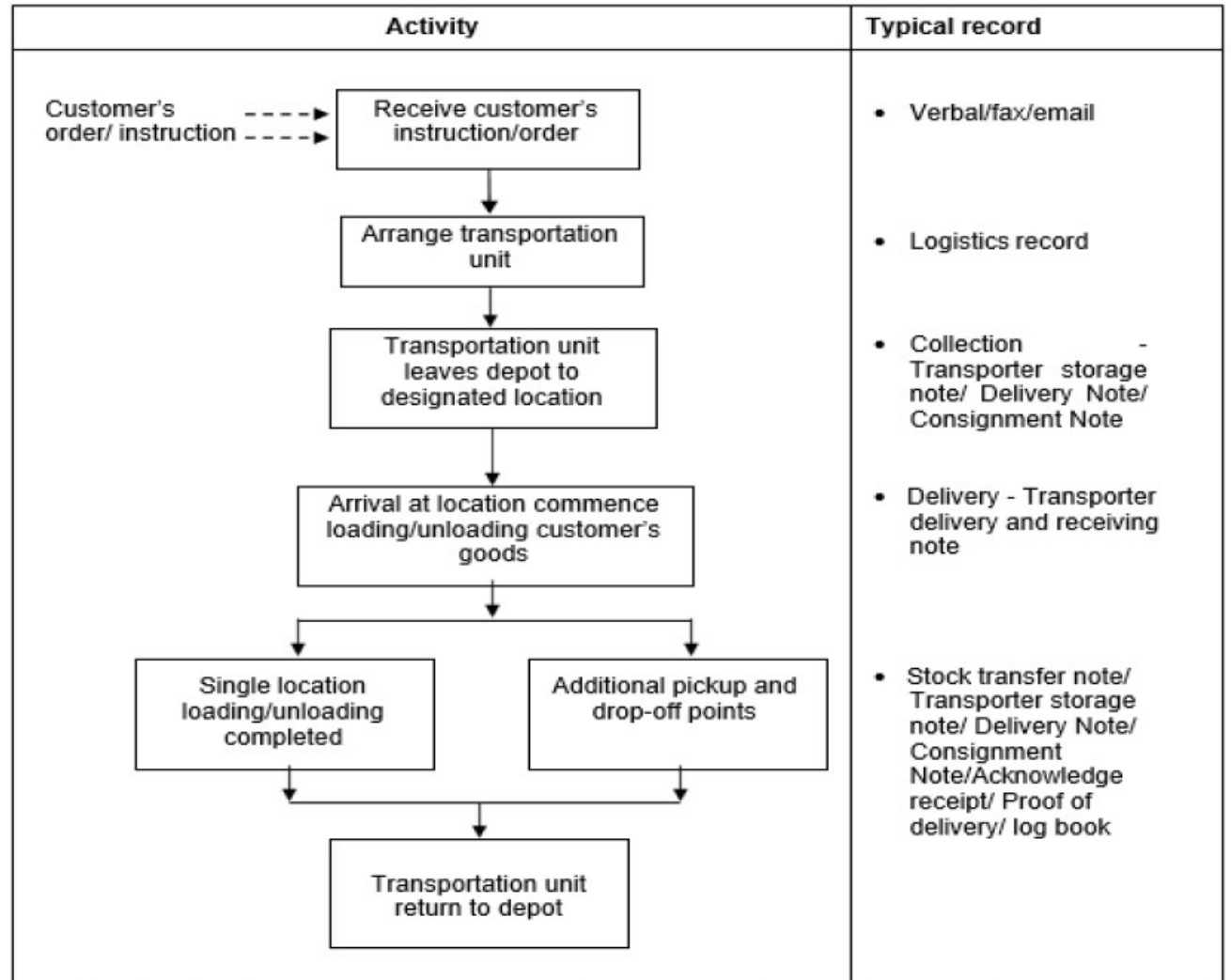


Figure 3 – Typical element and flow of transportation of products, goods and/or cargo chain services and related activities
